His height and reach also give him a notable advantage at the table. Laletin has competed in numerous prestigious arm wrestling tournaments. Notably, at King of the Table 5, he faced Dave Chaffee in a highly competitive match that went to a deciding seventh round, ultimately losing to Chaffee in a closely contested battle. This match is widely regarded as one of the most exciting in recent arm wrestling history. In the AMC Armwrestling tournament series, Laletin has consistently been a top performer. Voyevoda was among the worlds best arm wrestlers in the early 2000s, but he was not 10 times the World Armwrestling Champion. He did, however, win multiple major titles, including the WAF World Championship (both left and right hand in 2004), and the Zloty Tur (Nemiroff World Cup) in 2004. His victory over John Brzenk and Travis Bagent at the Zloty Tur 2004 Cup was a landmark achievement, famously documented in the film Pulling John. He was renowned for his brute static strength, especially demonstrated in high-profile matches against Travis Bagent and Andriy Pushkar. His right arm was considered among the strongest in Europe during his prime. Voyevoda made a brief return to arm wrestling in September 2023, losing to John Brzenk at King of the Table 8. Chaffees list of achievements is impressive: he is a two-time World Armwrestling League (WAL) Super Heavyweight Champion, a PAL International Super Heavyweight Champion, and a WAF World Champion. His matches are widely discussed in international arm wrestling communities, and he has competed in major events such as the WAL, Top 8, Nemiroff World Cup, and King of the Table (KOTT), where he has secured multiple titles. In June 2013, he was defeated by Cyplenkov in A1 Russian Open World Armwrestling Grand Prix and regained the title by defeating Cyplenkov the very next year. On 14 November 2018, Andrey Pushkar passed away in a traffic crash while driving in the Rivne region, along with Oleg Zhokhs (another arm wrestler) father. Travis Bagent, known as The Beast, is one of the most accomplished and charismatic figures in professional arm wrestling. With over 30 years in the sport, he has secured 13 world titles and 25 U.S. national titles, competing across multiple weight classes and federations. Travis has won five AAA Nationals titles between 1999 and 2003, and nine national right- and left-hand titles since 2000. He also the Mike Gould Classic title in 2006 and has multiple victories in prestigious tournaments like the Zloty Tur and the Iron Man Arm Wrestling Challenge. Regarding arm wrestling style, he is renowned for his explosive top-roll technique, which leverages hand control and positioning to overpower opponents. Bagents larger-than-life personality and trash-talking prowess have made him a fan favorite. He was featured in the 2014 AMC reality series Game of Arms, which showcased the lives and training of competitive arm wrestlers across the U.S. . His charismatic presence has also led to appearances on platforms like ESPN and the NFL network, where he has become a central figure in his rise to fame. Their 1978 supermatch at the Silver Slipper casino in Las Vegas, where Dean defeated Arciero 20 , is often cited as the match that launched Deans reign as the unofficial king of arm wrestling. Deans unparalleled static strength was rooted in his upbringing as a farmer. He spent his early years harvesting cotton and tobacco and raising hogs, developing legendary farmer strength through hard, manual labor rather than formal gym training. This background set him apart from many of his peers and contributed to his ability to overpower almost any opponent. Cleve Dean passed away in 2011 at the age of 58, but his legacy as one of the strongest and most dominant arm wrestlers of all time remains undisputed. Denis Cyplenkov, known as The Russian Hulk, is a Ukrainian-born Russian professional arm wrestler, former strongman, and former powerlifter. While Cyplenkov began his arm wrestling journey in Ukraine and Russia years earlier, he first gained widespread international recognition in 2008 when he defeated Andrey Pushkar 60 in a left-hand supermatch at PAL Vendetta #33. Throughout the late 2000s and early 2010s, Cyplenkov did not compete in every major event but instead focused on the most prestigious international tournaments, such as the Nemiroff World Cup (Zloty Tur), where he displayed his extraordinary talent. In every situation, his technique and sports knowledge enabled him to use his strength. The connective tissue of his elbow and forearm makes his hand back pressure and side pressure tremendous.
